




NAVIGATING CATCOURSES

- The Navigation Bar will be on the left side of the screen
- Through the Navigation Bar you can access your Account Settings, Dashboard, Course list, Calendar, Inbox, and Help menu
 - The Help Menu provides 24/7 support for CatCourses
- Click the left arrow button at the bottom of the Navigation Bar to hide the bar

YOUR ORIENTATION CATCOURSE SITE

- Your Orientation CatCourse site will use three main components:
 - 1. Modules Organizes course content into groups (aka, "Modules") to help you navigate the content in a curated order
 - 2. Pages & Assignments "Assignments" and pages will be used interchangeably on your Orientation CatCourse site and will display information and resources
 - 3. Discussions Your Orientation Leaders will interact with you through several Discussions
 - Do not share personal or private information you are not comfortable with your fellow students viewing
